Our Foundation recently initiated the In Memoriam program together with Funeral Chapels throughout the province. This program has proven to be a very effective method for family and friends to express their sympathy to the families who are grieving the recent death of a loved one.

Each funeral chapel in Saskatchewan has been provided with a supply of Knights of Columbus Charitable Foundation In Memoriam envelopes to be used at funerals. It is our hope that individual Knights, together with their families, consider including the Saskatchewan Knights of Columbus Charitable Foundation as one of their Charities of Choice when speaking with their funeral chapel director.

If you wish to make a donation at a funeral, ask the local funeral director for the In Memoriam envelope. The donation can then be given either to the funeral director or your local KC Council to be forwarded to the Foundation office for tax receipts to be issued. The family will also receive acknowledgment of your contribution.

We also ask that each Knight consider this personally as well and let your families know in order that they can specify this request in the Obituary notices and on the Memorial Cards. The Funeral Chapel will facilitate this if requested by the family.
