### **Unspent Convention Dollars**

**Wheelchairs** - The Sask Knights of Columbus received a shipment of 60 wheelchairs in Saskatoon on March 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

There are chairs for youth as well as adults. Each of the chairs has the Knights of Columbus logo embroidered into the fabric. The price per wheelchair is \$225.00

**Coats for Kids** - The Sask Knights of Columbus has just purchased 50 boxes of Coats through a special promotion in partnership with Supreme Council. The coats have been delivered to Saskatoon.

Councils can purchase a box of 12 coats for a total purchase price of \$200.00. That is less than \$20.00 a coat. The boxes are available on a "first pay first get" basis. Councils can purchase the box(es) now and not pick them up until later this fall. Purchase means funds in the Sask K of C Charitable Foundation bank account. The final date for a pick-up is December 31, 2020.

This is a one-time offer and once the 50 boxes are purchased by Councils the special offer is complete.

**K of C Vocation Endowment** - The Sask K of C Charitable Foundation is concluded the second year of our three year campaign on Tuesday, March 31, 2020

In partnership with the Bishops, priests, councils and parishes we began the third year of our campaign on April 1, 2020. We have again established a target of \$250,000.00 in year 3.
