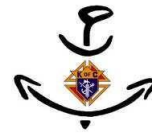

The following guidelines apply when considering grant applications:

- a. For purposes of definition, the Saskatchewan Knights of Columbus Charitable Foundation regards charity as a means of showing Christian love and goodwill to others. Charity is generosity and helpfulness to those in need. It also includes public benevolence that ranges from providing the basic needs of life to the support of those things that make life better.
- b. The priority of the Saskatchewan Knights of Columbus Charitable Foundation is the Church and Church-related needs and charities. We operate in a manner that recognizes that Knights of Columbus are first and always Catholic.
- c. The Saskatchewan Knights of Columbus Charitable Foundation operates in partnership with the Knights of Columbus Councils throughout the province of Saskatchewan. Priority is given to applicants that are also receiving funding and/or are working together with local Councils and their members.
- d. The Saskatchewan Knights of Columbus Charitable Foundation will also consider the special needs of individual brother Knights, their families and the communities where they live.
- e. Applications should be made in original form, with supporting background and financial information. Form letter requests will not be considered nor responded to.
- f. Delegates to the Saskatchewan Knights of Columbus Charitable Foundation Annual Meeting are provided with a report on Annual Grants approved.

The application deadline is February 15th. A committee reviews applications with recommendations presented to a board meeting. Approved Grants are distributed after the Annual General Meeting in April or early May of each year.
